In accordance with the Seabird Egg Conservation and Harvest Regulation Act of 1999 (SECRRA-86), the collecting and/or acquiring of seabird eggs is no longer permitted. See Section 3. (a), as outlined below:

Section 3. Permit Requirement:

(a). No person shall collect, possess, transport, sell, or offer for sale any seabird egg without a valid Seabird Egg Collection Permit issued by the Alaskan Department of Natural Resources, through the Division of Animal Resources.
